Foot bath units claiming to generate both positive & negative ions

Background: If you have spent anytime researching ionic foot baths you have, no doubt, come across competing units that claim to generate both negative *and* positive ions by reversing the polarity of the anode and cathode, cycling back and forth between generating positive and negative ions. This is often touted as the reason why these units are the ultimate among ionic foot baths, and why they are worth \$2500, \$3000, or more. We have news for you...

The Truth: All ionic foot baths mainly generate negative ions and any claim to the contrary is simply marketing babble. Going further, there is no evidence that positive and negative polarities is anything more than a gimmick.

Competitor Challenge:

Good News... We have \$10,000 waiting for you!

Bad News..... You will have to document and publish proof that:

- 1.) Cycling polarities during a session does anything to increase the generation of positive ions.
- 2.) Even if any meaningful amount of positive ions *were* created during this cycling process, what additional benefit does that provide the individual when compared the negative ion generating cycle. Good luck.
